Decision details

I have decided to grant Andrew Reeve's practising certificate for the practice year 2024/2025 subject to the imposition of the following conditions:

- 1. Mr Reeves' may act as a solicitor, only as an employee and only where that employment has first been approved by the SRA
- 2. Mr Reeves may not act as a compliance officer for legal practice (COLP) or compliance officer for finance and administration (COFA) for any authorised body.
- 3. Mr Reeves does not hold or receive client money, or act as a signatory to any client or office account or have the power to authorise transfers from any client or office account

In these conditions, the terms are as defined in the SRA Glossary.

Reasons/basis

The above conditions are necessary in the public interest and reasonable and proportionate having regard to the purposes set out in Regulation 7 of the SRA Practising Regulations 2011 and the regulatory objectives and principles governing regulatory activities as contained in section 28 of the Legal Services Act 2007.
