Outcome details

This outcome was reached by SRA decision.

Reasons/basis

This notification relates to a Decision to prosecute before the Solicitors Disciplinary Tribunal. This is an independent Tribunal which will reach its own decision after considering all the evidence, including any evidence put forward by the Solicitor. The Tribunal has certified that there is a case to answer in respect of allegations which are or include that, whilst in practice as a solicitor, Mr Nicholas Jackson: -

1. On or around 6 July 2022, when acting for Company A in a property transaction, certified that copies of identification documents for



- Person A, Company A's director, were true and complete copies of the original document, when he had not seen recently and / or at all the original documents; and
- 2. Provided the certified copy documents to another party in the transaction when asked to.

The allegations are subject to a Hearing before the Solicitors Disciplinary Tribunal and are as yet unproven.
