Warning: Website profile for 'Bennett Oakley' misusing the name of Bennett Oakley Solicitors

A profile has been set up on the website 'www.fiverr.com' misusing the name of a genuine firm and purporting to offer legal services.

What is the scam?

The SRA has been informed of a profile on the freelance services marketplace Fiverr with the name 'Bennett Oakley'. This profile purports to be for an individual who is a 'qualified UK conveyancing solicitor with expertise in land registry, transfers, TR1/AP forms, lease agreements and company property conveyance'. The profile also suggests that the individual is regulated by the SRA.

The SRA does not authorise or regulate individual solicitor named 'Bennett Oakley'.

Any business or transaction through the profile 'Bennett Oakley' on the website Fiverr is not undertaken by a firm or individual authorised and regulated by the SRA.

Is there a genuine firm or person?

The SRA authorises and regulates a genuine firm of solicitors of Bennett Oakley Limited which also uses the trading name of Bennett Oakley Solicitors (SRA ID 613332).

Bennett Oakley Solicitors has confirmed it has no connection to the profile referred to in the above alert.

What should I do?

When a firm's or individual's identity has been copied exactly (or cloned), due diligence is necessary. If you receive correspondence claiming to be from the above firm(s) or individual(s), or information of a similar nature to that described, you should conduct your own due diligence by checking the authenticity of the correspondence by contacting the law firm directly by reliable and established means. You can contact the SRA to find out if individuals or firms are regulated and authorised by the SRA and verify an individual's or firm's practising details. Other verification



methods, such as checking public records (e.g. telephone directories and company records) may be required in other circumstances.
